"Europe 2020" target

Employment -

75 % of the population aged 20-64 should be employed.

✓ 80 million people in the EU have a disability

One in eight people in working age have a disability or chronic condition

✓ 78% of the people with 'severe' disabilities of working age are outside of the labour market

✓ 50% of people with disabilities have acquired their disability during their working life. Very few return to work.

✓ 117 thousands of people have disabilities in Latvia.


The main barriers to the employment of people with disabilities

- 1. Lack of education and training (professional and social)
- 2. Lack of understanding of the needs of PwD from the point of view of employers
- 3. Need for special features for the job
- 4. Inaccessible environment
- 5. Inadequate synthesis between benefits and employment
- 6. Own disability

Flexicurity

Flexicurity is an effective measure to include disabled people in the labour market

- 1. Labour market flexibility flexible and reliable contractual arrangements
- 2. Comprehensive lifelong learning strategies
- 3. Effective Active Labor Market Policies (ALMPs)
- 4. Modern, adequate and sustainable social protection systems
