### **Project description**

The "Language of Tolerance" project was invented and created by the involvement of 40 young people in age of 16-22 years old from Poland, Italy, Slovak Republic and Latvia. It is an integration project where deaf people meet with hearing peers to work together to learn cooperation and tolerance through sports initiatives. Together we will organize the "Tolerance Run". During more than the week we will have a series of meetings and classes where we will gain knowledge and new skills through: work in international integration groups, creative presentations, theater workshops, brainstorming, video recording. We want to promote the integration of hearing and deaf youth and increase the participation of deaf people in the local community's social life.

The project will be attended by **40 people from Slovak Republic, Latvia, Italy and Poland (10 people per national team: 1 group leader, 1 translator/assistant and 8 participants aged 16-22).**

As a young people and students, we have passions and hobbies, which we wish to develop, therefore we have created this project. We have planned many activities that we are going to realize using methods of non-formal education and using English for communication (integration games, themed activities, discussions, evaluations, city game, national and regional evenings, meetings with local community etc.).

The project will be an opportunity for us to gain valuable experience, knowledge, new friendships and attitudes, that will have a positive influence on our future.
